Eatonville Could be the National Headquarters for a Major Company

HostDime.com, a cloud hosting data center, that is currently located in Eatonville (behind the Office Furniture Outlet), hopes to base its national headquarter in Eatonville. The Town Council and OCPS have agreed on a price to sell HostDime 5 acres of the Hungerford School property. "We are very conscious about the community," said HostDime CEO Manny Vivar. "When we designed this facility, we kept the local education system and community in mind. We are creating a 'how-it-works' space in the facility so young students can be exposed to the behind-the-scenes of how a data center works and how it powers the cloud." HostDime plans to provide WiFi access for the entire town too. They hope to close on the property soon and start construction later this year.

Hungerford Elementary School will be Rebuilt in 2017/2018

Orange County Public Schools representatives have announced plans to build a new school in Eatonville. They also plan to retain an existing, newer building on the current site for adult education services. In addition, OCPS hopes to rebuild in partnership with the Boys and Girls Club so the two organizations could share facilities. OCPS will host community meetings to get your thoughts on the new school design during 2016. The current building would continue to be used at the school during construction and will be torn down upon completion.

Town's Master Plan is Being Updated!

The Eatonville Community Redevelopment Agency (CRA) has updated its CRA Master plan for the Town input from over 150 residents at 4 community workshops. Residents should attend CRA workshops and Board meetings at Town Hall to continue to provide input on this plan. The Town can only use its CRA tax revenue for items that are in the plan.
