The Hungerford Property Is Up for Sale

On March 28th, 2016, the Orange County School Board and Town of Eatonville received seven applications in response to their request for information from persons interested in purchasing the Hungerford School Property,



located at the corner of Wymore Road and Kennedy Boulevard in Eatonville. In addition, OCPS also received one application for the property located at Kennedy Boulevard and Keller Road property, also in Eatonville.

Orange County Public School officials' want to sell the site of the former Hungerford High School to the Town of Eatonville and gave Eatonville a lease with the option to purchase the property. The Town of Eatonville has an agreement with OCPS to jointly seek a developer who would partner with the Town of Eatonville to develop the site. The Eatonville Town Council will make the final

decisions regarding the development of that site during 2016.

The applications are being reviewed to determine if the bidders meet the qualifications and a committee will begin to review them during May. OCPS will then request full proposals from the qualified developers. For more information, contact the Town of Eatonville staff at 407-623-8900.
